

Electrical Survey and Future Works update

Some of you may have noticed we have lost some power to sockets around the hangar and workshops.

This is as it should be. We are undergoing a well needed electrical survey, repairs and updates to comply with current regulations and to ensure we keep us and our visitors safe.

The Survey work was completed this Wednesday and once we receive the reports we'll decide under their expertise a plan of repairs and upgrades in priority of the higher used areas and the high risk items. I will try to let everyone know when work will be done.

In the meantime be patient, observant and most of all do not attempt rabbit runs or altering electrical supplies.

Please use alternative sockets and where necessary cable extension which is in good repair.

Be aware that some areas are not protected by RCD and extra care is to be taken when running long cables across wet floors or contaminated areas.

Some main distribution fuse boxes contain asbestos and others have been illegally rigged with fuse wire in them and if touched could prove hazardous or even fatal.

Anyone wishing to do electrical work or has a specific additional power supply or ad hoc requirement, then please notify the committee and we'll assign someone to discuss the requirement.

If you have work already in progress or are working on anything electrical again get in touch through the committee. If you have sensitive equipment that requires constant power then get in touch.

Under no circumstances is anyone to do any alterations or modifications to consumer boxes, power distribution panels or switching beyond fuse replacement without consultation for the immediate future.

This will allow us to establish an electrical plan for the whole club and finalise a certificate
